CAMP NORTHLAND EXPERIENCE

Reena is privileged to have a wonderful integration opportunity with Camp Northland, located on Moose Lake in the Haliburton Highlands. Camp Northland is a fully functioning overnight camp that offers a wide range of water and land sports, and recreational activities. All meals (Kosher-under COR) and tuck are included.

This is an inclusion program with participants living in their own cabin supported by Reena staff. Participants will join in the camp rotation of activities. Participants may attend more than one session if interested. All sessions last 6 days/5 nights except for Week 3. Week 3 is an 8-day/7 night program geared towards more independent clients at a 1:3 ratio.

This program is for children ages 7 - 15.

Children turning 16 by program start date may attend.

Transportation to and from Camp Northland is provided. The camp is not wheelchair accessible.
