

CLEANING FOR COVID-19

- COVID-19 (novel coronavirus 2019) is a respiratory illness that spreads between people who are in close contact with another (within 6 feet) through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs or sneezes. These droplets can land on nearby people and surfaces.
- COVID-19 can remain on surfaces, however, if it is properly cleaned and sanitized, the virus can be killed. It is best practice to routinely clean and sanitize high contact surfaces in households.



Step 1

Clean surfaces using a detergent, clean water and a clean brush or paper towel.



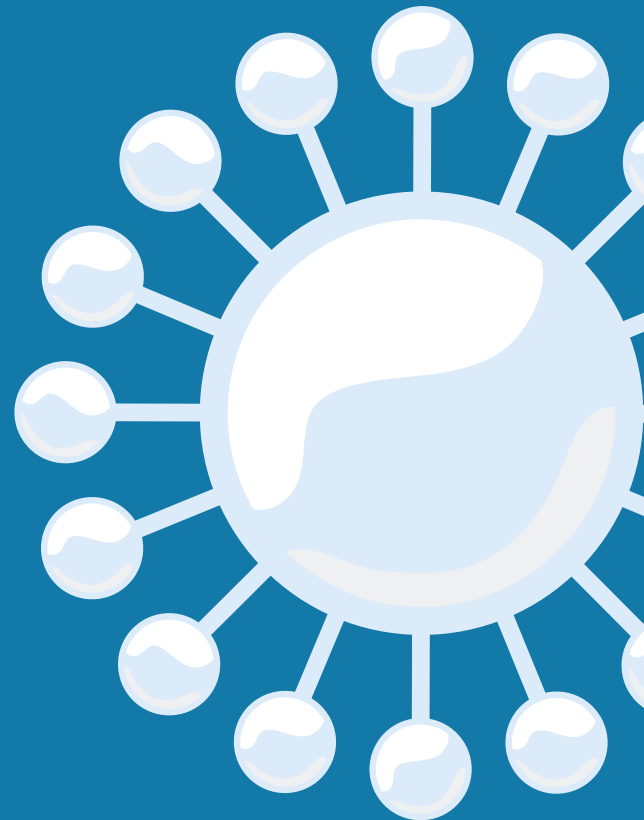
Step 2

Rinse surfaces to remove soap residue, loosened dirt and debris



Step 3

Disinfect surfaces using a Reena approved disinfectant, or a diluted household bleach solution (5000ppm/1 part bleach to 9 parts water)
