



COVID-19 (March 2020) Passenger Van Sanitizing

We need to recognize that the passenger van/vehicle is a confined space with many touch surfaces, occupants may have been in a public setting where they may pick up some contaminants from public surfaces.

Cleaning and sanitizing of the vehicle should be performed before and after an outing.

Using a general-purpose cleaner, all visible soil must be removed from:

1. door handles
2. seat arm rest
3. grab bars
4. seat belt latches
5. steering wheels
6. drivers' controls
7. Dashboard
8. any easily reached touch surface from the passenger seats

Once clean the surfaces must be sanitized with an approved sanitizer spray and wiped with a paper towel, Sanitizing wipes should only be used for electronic components, key remotes or surfaces that would not tolerate a liquid spray.
